

### **BorgWarner schließt Vertrag mit globalem OEM über die Lieferung von Kühlmittelheizern**

- *Technologie soll in europäischen Pkw des Automobilherstellers eingesetzt werden*
- *Unterstützt optimale Batterietemperatur und damit schnelles Laden*
- *Produktionsstart für 2026 geplant*

Auburn Hills, Michigan, 7. November 2023 – BorgWarner wird seinen 400-V- Kühlmittelheizer (High Voltage Coolant Heater, HVCH) an einen großen globalen OEM für dessen europäisches Pkw-Programm liefern. Der Produktionsbeginn ist für das Jahr 2026 vorgesehen. Dieser Auftrag ist bereits der zweite HVCH-Vertrag, den BorgWarner innerhalb von zwei Monaten mit dem weltweit agierenden Kunden abgeschlossen hat. Die Aufträge beziehen sich auf verschiedene Regionen. Damit stärkt BorgWarner seine Position als agiler Partner mit weltweiten Lösungen, der den OEM bei seinen künftigen batterieelektrischen Fahrzeugplattformen (BEV) unterstützen kann.

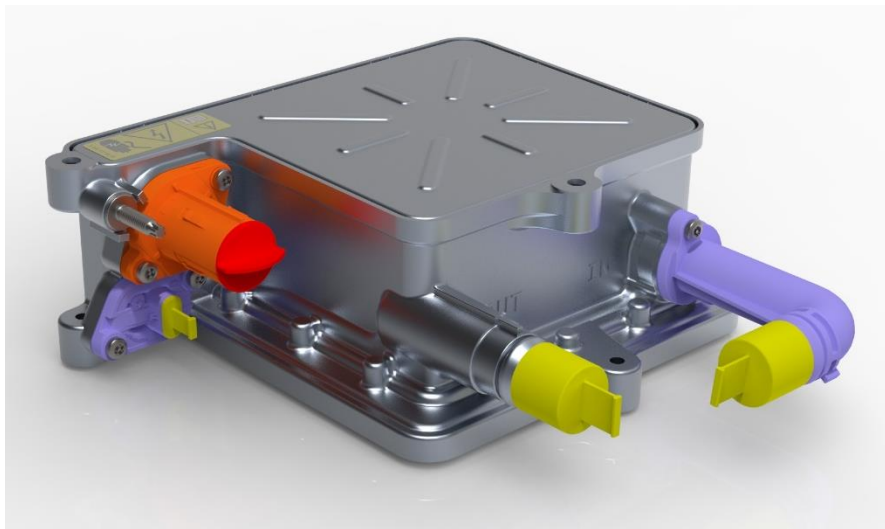
„Wir freuen uns, diesen globalen Automobilhersteller mit unserer HVCH-Technologie für seine kommenden BEV-Plattformen auszustatten und damit unsere langjährige Beziehung weiter auszubauen“, sagte Joe Fadool, President und General Manager von BorgWarner Emissions, Thermal and Turbo Systems. „Unser Entwicklungsteam hat bei diesem Projekt verschiedene Herausforderungen bezüglich Packaging sehr erfolgreich gemeistert. Letztendlich hat sich gezeigt, dass der HVCH von BorgWarner am besten geeignet ist und die Erwartungen des Kunden hinsichtlich Anpassungsfähigkeit und Skalierbarkeit erfüllt.“

Der 400V HVCH verfügt über ein modulares Design mit hoher thermischer Leistungsdichte, das speziell für die Beheizung der Batterie und der Kabine eines reinen BEV entwickelt wurde. Er stellt eine leichte, kompakte Lösung dar, die den Anforderungen des OEM an Größe und Gewicht gerecht wird. Die Technologie ermöglicht durch verbesserte Batterietemperierung schnelles laden. Ihre niedrige Schaltfrequenz hilft, die Kosten zu

optimieren. Dabei erfüllt sie zahlreiche Anforderungen des Kunden an Packaging und Sicherheit. Dazu gehört auch die Verhinderung von thermischen Ereignissen durch eine automatische Abschaltung, falls es zu einem Fehler kommt.
